#### **New Berm/Dam**


Engineering design is a structure with a clay core and riprap cover layer.



A 25m wide spillway (blue dotted line) is designed into it to cope with the remote possibility of a 100-year flood.

Within that spillway is a lower and narrower crossvane spillway (red dotted line) that is designed to ensure a faster spring run-offand then achieve a target seasonal water level for 01 July (134.52 MASL).

#### **BASS LAKE WATER LEVEL ELEVATION 2021**




#### **LAKE STEWARDSHIP – PRIORITIES 2022**

Surface Water Quality


To protect and improve the water quality of the lake

#### **Activities that influence Water Quality**

- 1. Eutrophication: Gradual increase in the concentration of phosphorus, nitrogen, and other plant nutrients in an aging aquatic ecosystem such as a lake;
- 2. Climate Change: Factors like water temperature, increased stratification, precipitation, and ice cover duration, are big influences in modern times;
- 3. Preservation of Water Levels: Maintaining the lake's historic and natural water levels;
- 4. Healthy 'Ribbon of Life': The protection and maintenance of the ecosystem around the lake's shoreline;
- 5. Protecting Lake Health: Encourage and promote environmental awareness, responsibility, and education.










#### **WATER QUALITY SAMPLING & ANALYSIS**

#### **RVCA'S Watershed Watch**

- Each year, about 20 samples are taken BY RVCA at half our designated sampling locations. The results for 2020 are posted on our website;
- RVCA's 2021 program very modest due to COVID restrictions. Results to be finalized in Nov 2021;
- Water Rangers Project;
- Ontario Lake Partners Program;

#### PRIORITY #1 – WATER QUALITY TESTING & ANALYSIS

## **Decision - Upcoming Board Meeting - Nov 2021 Establish & Fund - Lake Association Supplementary Program**

- Similar to other lakes, the BLPOA proposes to institute its own supplementary testing & analysis program;
- In first year, plan on taking 25 samples at different sites with testing for Phosphorus, Nitrogen, coliforms and ecoli. (~\$80 per sample analysis);
- A volunteer group required to take samples and the analysis and reports will be performed by commercial facility – Cadeceon Labs

The proposed 2022 budget for such a program will be \$2,500
